National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting the **Central Universities – Common Entrance Test (CU-CET) 2021** for admission to the **Integrated/Under-Graduate (UI)** and **Post-Graduation (PG) Programmes** of 12 Central Universities for the **academic session 2021-22** in **CBT mode**, as per details given below.

Last Date of successful fee transaction	02 September, 2021 (upto 11:50 pm)
Dates of Examination	15, 16, 23 and 24 September 2021
Duration of Examination	120 minutes (02:00 hours)
Mode of exam	LAN Based CBT (Computer Based Test)
Pattern of exam	Objective Type comprising Multiple Choice Questions
Medium of Paper	Only English (other than language Courses)

Candidates may apply online only at <https://cucet.nta.nic.in> during the period specified above. Before applying for CU-CET 2021, candidates are advised to **check the eligibility criteria required by a particular participating University for a desired Programme**. The exam fee is also required to be paid online through payment gateway using debit/credit cards, internet banking, UPI or Paytm (for details please refer to the **Information Bulletin**). Those candidates who are **appearing in the final examination of the qualifying degree/certificate** are also eligible to apply.
